Enigma also subscribes to the UN Global Compact and annually publishes its Communication of Progress (COP)

Adsec/Enigma will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in Slavery or Human Trafficking.

The Company Directors and Senior Management shall take the responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resource (training etc) and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organization and within its supply chains.
